

LANDSCAPE VILLA

The thatched villa lies peaceful and serene in a pine-forested landscape park. The three-story structure is made up of wings and sections of varying heights, combined with outdoor terraces and deliberately curated views. The garden, created by Piet Oudolf, offers a choice of purposes: picturesque trees, the outdoor pool, and sunken seating areas with a fire pit or barbecue. While the functions of a high-quality residence, including various lounge areas, dining area, kitchen, and five bedrooms, are assigned to bright rooms with meticulously coordinated atmospheres that are tied together by the Pietra dei Medici stone flooring, this country house offers an astonishing number of other opportunities for delightful leisure pursuits. Health and fitness are catered for by an indoor pool, a spa with sauna, and a gym, and a walk in the woods with a beloved four-legged friend can be followed by use of the built-in dog shower in the entrance area. For relaxed gourmet pleasures or hobbies, there is a media room and a wine cellar with

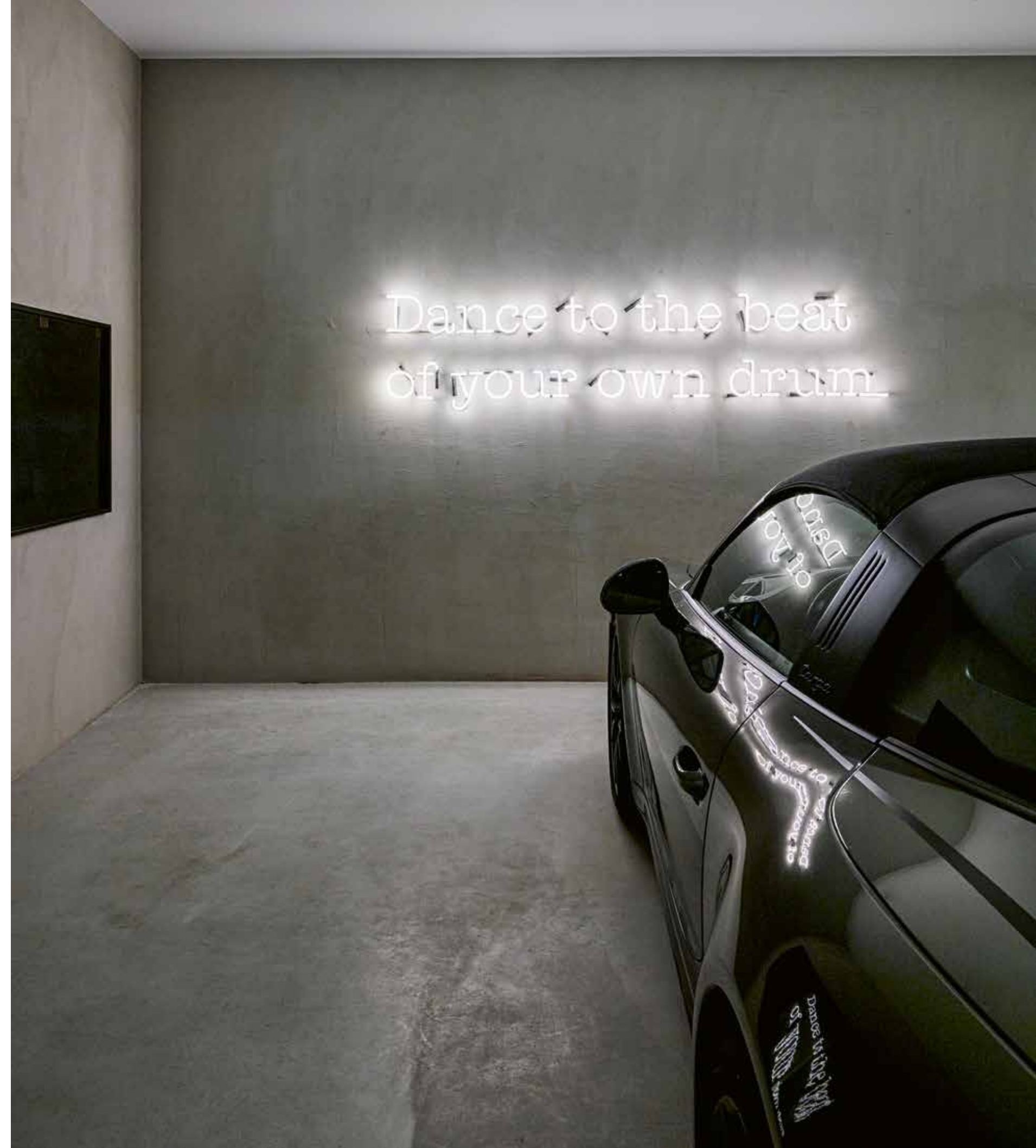

countertop for convivial tastings. A special feature is the basement brewery. By no means a small enterprise, it contains several floor-to-ceiling vats for uninterrupted brewing, distilling, cooling, and, of course, tasting—also for the owner's restaurant business. The icing on the cake is delivered by his passion for cars, which can also be indulged to the full here. Like a natural ramp integrated into the greenery of the garden, a driveway leads down to a large underground car park. Access is effortless, and vehicles are parked in a protected and dry space that is also a stylish gallery of light art objects, including a neon sign with the inspiring motto "Dance to the beat of your own drum." A philosophy that could be taken further as far as architecture is concerned; when building a house, it is advisable to use the services of a creative architecture and design firm and experienced landscape architects. Together, they can create a harmonious ensemble that orchestrates your personal rhythm into a beautiful symphony.

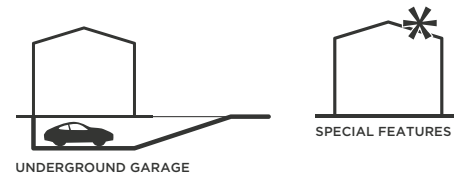
